LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1) In or beyond any boundary, fence or hedge of the course. The nearest inside points at ground level of any boundary, fence or hedge. The car park and the driving range, as defined by white posts.

LATERAL HAZARDS (Rule 26) Ditch alongside 1st/13th hole. Pump House out-take to left side of 3rd/15th hole. Stream alongside right of 7th hole. Lake to right of 7th hole. Lake to right of 9th hole for tee on far side of lake. Pond on left side of 11th/17th hole. All these to be identified by red posts.

WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26) Stream across 3rd/15th hole. Stream across 4th & 5th holes. Stream across 7th hole. Lake at 8th hole. Lake at alternative 9th tee (i.e. Near side of water) All these to be identified by yellow posts.

INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE (Rule 28) Any roads and unstaked trees within the boundary of the course are deemed to be an integral part of the course. The ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable. The ball may be lifted without penalty from any gravel or bark pathway and dropped.

STAKED TREES (Rule 24-2b)(1) Defined as any tree with a stake firmly attached within one club-length not nearer the hole.

If such a tree interferes with a players' stance or the area of the intended swing, the ball must be lifted without penalty (the ball may be cleaned) and dropped.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2) The building between the 2nd tee and the 3rd fairway. Benches, ball cleaners & tee signage plinths. **SPRINKLERS** All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction is within two club-lengths of the green and interferes with the line of play, relief without penalty may be obtained (Appendix 1 Part A4a).

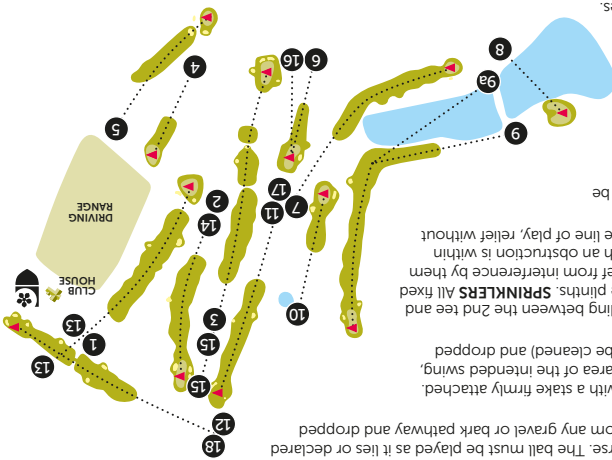
MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-1) Stones may be removed from bunkers.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR Any area circled by a white line and/or marked by a CLR sign is deemed to be Ground Under Repair from where relief may be taken as provided in Rule 25-1.
