Payment will be taken at the time of booking (GBP). To book a tee time online you will have to enter your credit or debit card details using our secure online payment process. You should print off or make a note of your booking reference as this will be required on arrival.
Refund / Cancellation Policy
=======================================
If you cannot attend your booking, please contact Brailsford Golf Course by email, golf@brailsfordgolfcourse.com or telephone, 01335 360 096.
We are unable to offer refunds but you will be offered an alternative date within 28 days of the original booking. Please have a preferred date in mind before you contact us.
No shows without prior cancellation (less than 4 hours prior to tee off time) are non-refundable and non-transferable.
Course Closed
=========
If you are unable to play your round of golf due to the course being closed (e.g. bad weather), you will be offered an alternative date within 28 days of the original booking.
Booking Transferable
=======================================
The booking is transferable. Therefore, should you be unable to make your tee time, you can offer it to someone else for example a family member or friend.
Dress Code
======
Normal golf dress code applies. The following are not permitted: denims, joggers, shorts, football/rugby tops, etc. For more information, please refer to our website.
Golf shoes MUST be worn. Spikes may be worn.
Personal (Public) Liability Insurance



Members of an England Golf affiliated golf club are provided with personal (public) liability insurance as part of their membership.

All non-members must have their own personal (public) liability insurance to play on any golf course. Therefore, golfers and visitors at Brailsford Golf Course play at their own risk and are not covered by the course's own insurance policies. Non-golfing visitors will need to hire a golf buggy and agree to the Course's Terms & Conditions to go on to the course.

Visitors supporting golfers who require assistance are permitted but must agree to our Terms and Conditions to go on the Course.
